Scholarship Scheme Information 2019-20

Garodia education exists to develop students of a strong academic standing alongside the development of personal character through an emphasis on values and morals. We are proud to announce to the community for a second year an opportunity for students to apply for Scholarships starting in July 2019.

Purpose

- To enable more students residing in the community to receive a high quality education.
- To build upon the excellent quality of education already delivered at GICLM.

Details

- Applications will be open to current Garodia students and also new applicants to GICLM.
- Candidates are welcomed from all National or International programmes.
- We are hoping to award a minimum of 20 scholarships available for successful candidates from Grades 6 to 9 (Cambridge curriculum) and Grade 11 (International Baccalaureate curriculum). In the event of exceptional candidates, the Board reserves the right to increase the number of scholarships awarded.
- Please note: The precise allocations of final scholarships will depend upon the quality of student applicants. GICLM retain the right to adjust the final numbers or even not to offer any scholarships if candidates are unsuitable at specific grade levels. In that situation the total number of scholarships may be redistributed amongst other levels.
- Scholarships will be offered for a 100%, 50% and 25% reduction of school fees.
- Scholarships will last for a stated period:
For grades 6-8; until the end of grade 8.
For grade 9; until the end of Grade 10 and
For grade 11; until the end of Grade 12.
- Scholarships will be renewed annually and will be dependent upon the maintenance of academic performance and personal contributions to the community.
- Students are eligible to re-apply for any further scholarships in subsequent grade levels.
- Scholarship results will remain confidential to GICLM.
- **Please note this legal disclaimer: The decision about the award of scholarships is strictly at the discretion of the Scholarship Panel subject to School Board approval and is thus incontestable.**

Selection Criteria

- Students will need to demonstrate an outstanding level of personal character alongside academic ability and potential. The following areas will be evaluated for all candidates:

Intellectual ability	Personal attributes	Community engagement	Sporting abilities	Aesthetic abilities

- The award will be determined on a 'holistic' appreciation of each candidate.
- These criteria will be assessed through analysis of the application forms alongside the Open Examinations and Interview stages results.
